<p><u>Irregular Past Tense Verbs (List 2)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We have learned that the suffix <u>-ed</u> is usually added to verbs to show past tense. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>For example:</u> jump, jumped • The verbs below are <u>irregular past tense verbs</u> that <u>do not</u> follow the same pattern. You <u>cannot</u> add <u>-ed</u> to the base word. The base word changes to show past tense. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>For example:</u> catch, caught sleep, slept • For some words, the <u>irregular past tense verb</u> is the same as the word in the present tense.
